Srinivasa Institute of Management Studies has celebrated Youth Day in our college campus, on 10th January 2024. The guest was Dr S.P Ravindra, The National Youth Day marks the birth anniversary of a great Indian Saint, Spiritual Leader, and philosopher – Swami Vivekananda. Vivekananda was Ramakrishna Paramhansa's chief disciple in the 19th century. He founded the Ramakrishna Math, a monastic order in Kolkata based on his guru's teachings, and the Ramakrishna Mission, a global spiritual movement based on Vedanta, an ancient Hindu philosophy. In India, his birthday is celebrated as National Youth Day to honour one of the greatest spiritual and philosophical leaders of all time and to recollect his ideas on how young people should take part in the modern world while upholding their values. Vivekananda is credited with contributing to a revival of modern Hinduism and inspiring nationalist consciousness during colonial rule but he is best known for his famous 1893 speech where he introduced Hinduism to the Western world in Chicago. Swami Vivekananda died on July 4, 1902 but his writings and teachings had an impact on many of India's nationalist leaders, who were fighting against the colonial rule and while Subhas Chandra Bose called Vivekananda "the maker of modern India", Mahatma Gandhi said that after reading the works of Vivekananda, his love for his nation became a thousand-fold.

The constitution replaced the Government of India Act 1935 as the governing document of India, thus turning the nation from a dominion into a republic post its independence from the British Raj in 1947. The constitution was adopted by the Constituent Assembly of India on 26 November 1949 and came into effect on 26 January 1950. The date was chosen as the Indian National Congress proclaimed Purna Swaraj (complete independence) on this day in 1930.

Srinivasa Institute of Management Studies has organised a seminar on World Cancer Day in our college campus, on 4th Feburary 2022. Cancer is a increasing health challenge in India, impacting lives across diverse socio-economic and geographies of the country. The burden of cancer in the country is on the rise, with an increasing number of cases reported each year. Since 1981, the National Cancer Registry Programme (NCRP) under the Indian Council of Medical Research-National Centre for Disease Informatics and Research (ICMR-NCDIR). In 2022, the projected number of new cancer cases in India was 1,461,427, with a crude incidence rate of 100.4 per 100,000 individuals. Approximately one in nine people in India is expected to face a cancer diagnosis during their lifetime. Notably, lung cancer ranked highest among males, while breast cancer held the top spot for females. Within childhood cancers (0-14 years), lymphoid leukemia emerged as the predominant site, accounting for 29.2% in boys and 24.2% in girls. Looking ahead, an estimated 12.8% increase in cancer incidence by 2025 is expected as compared to 2020.







Srinivasa Institute of Management Studies has organised a seminar on World Cancer Day in our college campus, on 4th Feburary 2019. On behalf of this occasion students of BBA, MBA & MCA actively participated and made the event grand success. World Cancer Day 2019 highlights the need for urgent action to increase early-stage cancer detection, screening, and diagnosis to significantly improve cancer patients' chances of survival. Taking place under the theme of 'I Am and I Will', today's World Cancer Day led by the Union for International Cancer Control (UICC), aims to inspire and encourage action from individuals, the health community, and governments to improve public awareness and access to early detection, screening, and diagnosis. There is also an opportunity to increase awareness among doctors, nurses, and other health practitioners to improve early cancer detection, especially at the primary care level. In the UK, a study found that most people present cancer signs or symptoms at the primary care level in the year before their formal cancer diagnosis. However, even when a healthcare professional might suspect cancer, weak referral systems can oftentimes prevent them from efficiently referring these patients on to pathology services for diagnostic testing, which inevitably leads to needless delays in treatment. When suspected cancer patients do get referred for diagnostic testing, limited access to pathology services and diagnostic technologies can hold back health services from delivering early diagnoses and treatment of cancer. This is especially true in lowincome countries where there are a large number of late stage diagnoses - 35% of low-income countries reported that pathology services were generally available compared to more than 95% of high-income

countries.
